


Free vs Emulsified Water in Fuel – Do you know the difference?

What not everyone is aware of is the different types of water contamination, and how not all solutions deal with the entire problem. Do you know the difference between free, suspended and emulsified water and how they present themselves?

Suspended Water

Diesel can hold a certain amount of dissolved water before becoming problematic, which the diesel fuel specification says is around 200ppm. At this point fuel should still be clear and bright, however, as the water content goes beyond that it becomes suspended and makes fuel appear cloudy.

Free Water

As diesel becomes so full of suspended water that it can hold no more, it starts dropping free water out to the bottom of the tank, visible as a separate layer below the cloudy fuel. Free water can also be as a result of rainwater or condensation running down the walls of the tank.

Emulsified Water

Under pressure changes and agitation, often experienced as fuel passes through pumps and filters, water can become fully emulsified in fuel which sees it turning from cloudy to milky. This is where there is almost not separation between the fuel molecules and water content.

All water contamination pose risks to costly damage and downtime, yet it is amazing how many fuel tank owners are only dealing with part of the problem. Free water can be more easily sucked out from the bottom of the tank and removed before use by using standard filters. However, the suspended and emulsified often remains undealt with by any solution other than a fuel polishing service.

Aquafighter: The Complete Solution

Traditional water absorbers and standard fuel tank filters are cost effective solutions for dealing with free water. However, as you'll now understand, this is only dealing with part of the issue. Aquafighter is the only

fuel tank water absorber on the market that also removes the suspended and emulsified water, eliminating the problem that causes diesel bug sludge and engine and equipment damage.

The beauty of this solution is that all you need to do is simply place Aquafighter in the tank through the largest opening of a storage tank, genset belly tank or vehicle fuel tank, and it reduces water content levels down to less than 75ppm, meeting and exceeding the EN590 diesel fuel standards.



Fuel Industry Round Up for 2020

March 15th

The new Welsh oil storage regulations came into force, meaning that Welsh businesses with tanks storing over 2001 of fuel now need a secondary containment of 110% its capacity, with a £5,000 penalty for non-compliance.



June

UKIFDA launched their liquid biofuels campaign to ensure that the 2.18 million homeowners in the UK and Ireland who have oil heating have the option of liquid biofuels when it comes to decarbonising.

March 11th

Chancellor announced in his 2020 budget his plans for the change in the tax treatment of red diesel come 2022. With the construction and power generation industries set to pay just over 46p extra per litre.



May 26th

UKIFDA announced they had made the decision to cancel the fuel industry's annual exhibition due to COVID-19 restrictions and uncertainty. The show will return to Exhibition Centre Liverpool on the 19th and 20th May 2021.
